## Berlusconi and his End: Great Hopes and Bad Results

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Now we can add the name of Silvio Berlusconi to the long list of the governors who betrayed Italy. We are very very sorry, but this is the only possible and sad conclusion. Once he decided to step out of the scene, he could at least have done a great gesture in order to be remembered by History; but he never did anything that could be interesting for History. Since the battle was lost, instead of kneeling in front of the Bankers, Berlusconi should have rebelled against the *coup d'etat* enacted by the President of the italian Republic, mr. Napolitano. He should have said that he wanted to defend the democratic rights of the Italians, since this was his duty. There were two main reasons to say so, which were so self evident than nobody could argue against them, except his miserable enemies.

The first reason cannot be questioned: the Head of the Government had the precise duty of defending the Republic from the coup d'etat made by president Giorgio Napolitano, because Berlusconi was both Head of the Government and leader of the majority party in the Parliament. Instead he did not make the smallest gesture of resistance; he did not justify his resignation saying that he wanted to abide by the oath to the Laws of the Republic. In his last speech broadcasted on Tv. he even boasted that he sacrificed himself for the sake of Italy. Throughout the centuries Italy has seen so many people who betrayed the Law and the Constitution, and did not abide by their oath "for the sake of Italy"! This is the tragic destiny of the Italians! The have always been betrayed by their governors. Everyone justified himself in this way, while running away: Popes, Kings, dictators and generals. No pride, no dignity, no respect for the Truth: nothing. With his cowardice Berlusconi endorsed the subversive action that appointed a banker as the new Head of Government. He also undersigned his appointment as "lifetime Senator" which is just a trick to pretend that he was a politician. This dreadful fiction is bringing back sad memories of the worst events in the italian history. Italians were so caught by surprise that they are not able

to understand, to talk and to revolt. They admired and trusted Giorgio Napolitano, thinking he was the best of their Presidents. They do not realize yet what happened - but they will soon wake up. This will happen because of the enormous lie that supported the whole operation. This is the second reason I was talking about: the failure of the European unification.

The project of the European unification was wrong from its very beginning and it has failed. None of the things that it was supposed to achieve were realized. Unified Europe was thought to become the richest market of the world; instead it is a lot poorer and its single currency is pushing towards default most of the States that are using it. It in not possible to estimate the cost of what has been done. But to understand it, we can think about the foolish orders that were given by an european Parliament on the verge of hysteria, because it was enjoying an immense power with no limits: trembling and fearful, the poor european farmers had to obey. They had to destroy the best productions of fruit, to kill magnificent cows and beautiful pigs, to throw in the kitchen sink rivers of milk, oil, wine, under the angry glance of the God of the Poor and the Hungry. This is just one of the many proofs of the madness of Europe, of the dark and obscure swamp that it was forced to cross. The Bolshevik revolutionaries did the same to force the kulak to obey their 'just' planning. So did the Khmer Rouge in Kampuchea to destroy capitalism, tearing in pieces all the banknotes representing it. Until now in Europe there was no need to shoot anyone (but sooner or later force will be used) because everybody obeyed. People could not believe that democracy could become - as it did - the most foolish dictatorship. Now we are at a turning point. There is a widespread economic crisis, which was triggered by the Bankers, who are like the gamblers of Dostojewskji. As a reward for the trillions that they burned out, they are now directing - in the worst possible way - the economies of the single States. The boasted goal of the whole operation - the political unification - is completely out of reality (as it was logical to expect). Therefore France and Germany took the lead openly, with no hesitation in deciding for everybody else about wars and alliances; they show their superiority, and they are absolutely sure of their power over the subject nations.

In this situation, any person with common sense would abandon the old strategy, looking for a new one. Governors and Bankers, instead, do not want to acknowledge the failure, and keep saying the exact contrary: this is not default, this is happening because we did not do yet all what we should have done. Seventy years of egoism, of proofs, losses and defeats are not enough. They are not enough because - this is the main point - we are *not completely bankrup*t yet, and they *do not have a complete power* on everything yet. The real goal in fact was the

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destruction of Europe. The destruction of the national States in order to hand over all the power - including political power - to the bankers. We are not experts in economy but we understand this; do you really believe that they do not? Do you think that they did not foresee the disaster? Please! Mr. Ciampi, Prodi, Monti and Draghi are more proficient than us in maths. And if they were wrong, why should we call them to save us? Dear Italians don't you see that all this is completely insane?

The president of the Republic speeded up the process of handling power to the bankers. No wonder: as I said, italian governors are the biggest accomplices of our misfortunes. But now the pact of Democracy has been broken; and we, the citizens, are not supposed to keep faith to it. Deputies could keep up the appearances of democracy only if the do not vote for an illegitimate government and if they ask for new elections. The deputies of the Pdl have no obligations to obey Berlusconi, since he made this awful mistake. This would be the only way to stop the economic crisis: to say out loud to those who are strangling us that we are not playing this game any more. That once a new Parliament will be elected we will escape from the loop of the Euro, taking back our monetary sovereignty and independence. There are no other ways out. Will some of the deputies stand up and remember that he is italian?

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
