

Our Weakness is their Strength

The question of the new rules concerning the bathing of women in english swimming pools could at first seem a simple and funny story, suitable for the hot summer season. But everything in women's behavior, in every time and in every human society, is a mirror of the deepest meaning of a culture. Anthropologists know it very well: it is important to look at the way women live to understand a cultural model, and to know the values, the feelings and the passions of the men that created it.

Today England is almost completely submitted to the muslim's will; this does not mean that England gave up its traditions, but that it is not willing to evaluate and follow any rule or limit concerning its own or other people's habits. As far as the structure of the society is concerned, this is disheartening. But it is not by chance that it happened: the people who rule the world actually wanted it. The goals of the institutions that rule on world politics are very clear: people must be unified, must understand each other, be tolerant, assimilate, so that there will not be any difference between races, religions, habits, government systems, homelands, nations, territories, languages, money and markets. The names of the main planetary organizations make it very easy to understand this: "World Bank", "International Monetary fund", "Tavistock Institute for Human Relationship", "United Nations organization", "World Union of Churches" and so on.

Most of these organizations were born at the end of World War Two, after the trauma of the immense catastrophe that touched every country; the intention was to avoid that such terrible events would happen again in the future. From this stemmed out the idea of a sovra-national Power that would settle controversies, would limit nuclear weapons proliferation, would prosecute war criminals and so on. But this was just the first step. In a very short time, the goal became completely different: from avoiding a new war it switched to the planning of an Universal Peace.

The wars were always declared and made by the people who are in power - who pretend not to know it - and not by the citizens. Now the people in power have planned and are beginning to realize step-by-step the equalization and unification of different Peoples, using the Media and pushing them to submit to the same tastes, clothes, food and

amusements. This first step was not difficult at all to pursue, to say the truth. There was a market world planning, for a duty-free world without borders or barriers. Supermarkets are selling the same things everywhere: people had to make do, had to buy and use these things, although reluctantly. Pervasive advertising - the same in every country - made the rest: now everybody is listening to pop music and using chewing-gum.

The second step is more difficult: the free circulation of different goods and of different people. Enormous migrations started, and at the first sight of a negative reaction, there was a strong pressure to convince the subjects: *you have got to like it*. The governors decided to impose their will, without taking into consideration the results of two centuries of scientific research in the fields of Sociology, Anthropology, Ethnology. Not to mention several centuries of History which prove that it is not possible to have two different peoples living together in the same territory without producing terrible conflicts and, at the end, the supremacy of one over the other. The most important factor - of course - is religion because *each religion is a culture*, even if western politicians do not believe it. *There is no "culture" without a religion*.

Now let us go back to the main question: muslims are so strong in Europe because christianity became weak. This is due to a series of reasons that cannot be examined here: the main one - among others - is that it is not possible to place one's trust on the Church, both Catholic and Protestant. When priests - like the politicians - started to preach that we have to give up our own identity in order to respect the foreigner's one, putting aside all what we believed in and loved before, in that very moment there was a deep break and an inner bewilderment that cannot be overcome: we did not trust them anymore.

And *"Faith" is Trust*. The betrayal from Church and Priests produced a desertion of the religion that they represent. Priests forgot that in the past they had preached that religious truth was only one. The ability to judge following a logical system is the only guidance man has for his survival. *If all religions are true, then none of them is true*. This simple consideration had a devastating impact in Europe. The logical route between Aristotle and Galileo was created in Europe until it produced the explosion of Science. Now it is impossible to go back from this awareness.
