Rom: the Conflict between France and the European Union

The fight between France and the European Union caused by the forced repatriation of groups of illegal Rom people decided by the French Government is becoming more and more fierce. But we must understand that it is impossible to have solutions from the European Union; we must also hope that the European Union will *not* offer solutions because they would always go against our interests and be in favor of the immigrants. In short, we must face reality: immigration is pursued, encouraged, helped and pushed-in by the European Union. But this is not happening because of the virtues of solidarity, goodness, and acceptance that are being boasted. That is just a façade, and not a very credible one, since it is coming from a State. Before the European Union, History never saw the advent of "Virtuous" States.

European Union was created in order to *eliminate* the States and the Nations. Politicians already did all what was in their power to achieve this

goal: Super-national institutions, single currency, citizenship, cancellation of borders and so on. But it is the People who create Nations and States, not the contrary. This is the harsh reality (harsh for them) but politicians and bankers did not want to take it into account when they were planning the European unification. The best tool to destroy Peoples is immigration: the massive presence of foreigners, of people with different languages, customs and religions. The European Union planned immigration. But now we reached a critical point: the governors of the single States and of the European Union do not know how to solve the question, because they never said openly to their citizens which was their final goal: the death of Nations and of the single States. And this is not even the real goal: European unification is just a first stage along the path towards Globalization. It's been many years that bankers and economists pursue this result.

We are in mid-stream, as are the Parties of the Left. They are experiencing a total void, they do not have ideas nor men. This is why they are thinking about calling back their main expert of Globalization, mr. Romano Prodi. They do not dare to say to their followers that they should support and fight for the same ideals of the bankers: the European Union and Globalization. But what can they do? I have a suggestion: they should put their cards on the table and openly discuss about the only true dilemma that we have ahead of us: should we save the States or go on towards Globalization?
